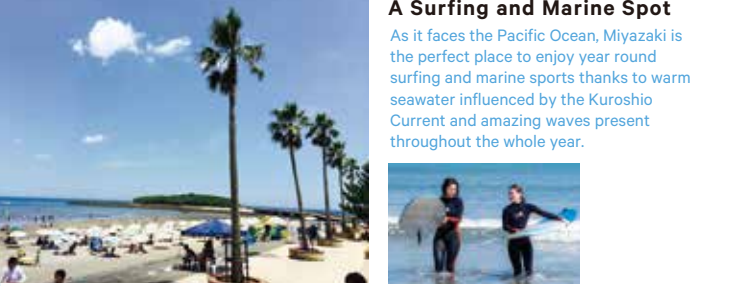

# Driving Course

**1 JR Miyazaki Station** Miyazaki City Center Map

All trains will stop at Miyazaki City's selected main station. At the exit of Takachiho Station, there is a facility, KITTEN that also has a bus terminal, and a shopping area, 'Amu Plaza Miyazaki', in front of the station, making it a good stopping point to Miyazaki City.

**2 Southern bypass** C-4

Head south on Route 220 and once you've passed Miyazaki Airport, you will see a vast rural landscape from the east to west. You will see the shining 'Sun Marine Stadium Miyazaki' which was named by Mr. Shigeo Nagashima, a man named as a lifelong honorary manager of the Yomiuri Giants.

**3 Aoshima Bypass Parking** D-5

Here you can visit an observatory where you can view Aoshima and its cityscape below, as well as Miyazaki City and Seagala in the far north.

**4 Horikiri Pass** D-5

If you drive in the direction of the Phoenix Roadside Station, a breathtaking panorama will appear before you. Horikiri Pass is the entrance to Nichinan Kaigan Quasi-National Park, which has a truly spectacular view.

**6 Noshima Shrine** Outside of the Map

A shrine that still tells the legend of Urashima Taro. The Aka tree that towers over the precincts is over 300 years old and has been designated as a National Nature Monument.

**7 Iruka Cape** Outside of the Map

A cape on the southernmost tip of Miyazaki City and runs along the border of Nichinan City.

**5 Kibana Shrine** C-4

A shrine dedicated to Ninigi no Mikoto and Princess Konohanasakuya, the parents of Umisachihiko and Yamasachihiko. In the precincts, there are remains of the room where Princess Konohana Sakuya was said to have given birth. ☎985-58-0229

The town will come alive for two days with the heroic 'Danjin Kenka' and 'Trota Kudaki Odori'.
- [ Late July ] **Matsuri Erocokka Miyazaki**  
This is a big event held along the city's central street to help make summer in Miyazaki even more exciting. The highlights include the dance contests and food.
- [ August ] **Miyazaki Gourmet and Lantern Night**  
You can enjoy Miyazaki's excellent food to the fullest in a fantastic area surrounded by more than 10,000 lanterns.
- [ Early August ] **Miyazaki Noryo Fireworks Festival**  
Fireworks color the night sky and reflect on the surface of the Oyodo River while the cheers of the viewers echo throughout summer nights.
- [ Late August ] **Miyazaki Aoshima International Beer Festival**  
A large collection of famous beers from around the world. You can enjoy local cuisine and summer stamina foods from various areas of the world.
